Outpatient Drug-Free Services (ODFS)

Primarily group therapy for adults 18 years of age and older.

Perinatal Intensified Outpatient Treatment

12-week program that addresses substance abuse disorders, motherhood and parenting, relapse prevention, and goal setting. Phase II is an additional 3-9 months.

Drug Court Program

Treatment and other services in conjunction with the courts.

Aftercare Services *For adults 18 years and older who have completed a regular AOD treatment program. Focused on relapse prevention and recovery maintenance.*

Dual Diagnosis Services

For adults 18 years and older with co-occurring disorders.
